

HIGH SCHOOL FEES

- *A waiver of fees or a discount of 80% is available for qualifying students.*
- *Waivers and reductions are ONLY for lab fees and locker rental and do not apply to charges for student parking, damage or loss to textbooks, calculators or other school equipment.*
- *AP exam fees are added to student account after exam sign-ups.*

LAB FEES

Fees for Science, Business/Computers, Marketing, Art, Digital Imaging, and Theatre help offset the cost of consumable items used in the classroom. In the Computer and Marketing labs this includes the cost of printer ink, paper, disks, etc. and in Art and Digital Imaging, fees help offset the cost of paint and other drawing mediums, paper, matting, disks, etc. The Science Department uses consumables such as chemicals, testing mediums, and specimens. Theatre classes will use materials to create sets as part of the curriculum. Please check your student schedule with the following list to find applicable fees.

LOCK RENTAL

The locker rental fee is \$3.00 (60 cents if qualified for discount). Unless a student has the permission of the principal, personal locks are prohibited.

STUDENT PARKING PERMIT

Parking Permits for the entire school year are \$40.00. If permit is purchased after September, this amount is pro-rated at \$5.00 for each month remaining in the year. There are limited student spots. Assignments are first come, first serve.

TEXTBOOKS and CALCULATORS

Textbooks and calculators are provided free of charge, however if damaged or not returned to school upon completion of the course, a fine or replacement fee will be assessed on books and a replacement charge of \$50.00 will be assessed for calculators. Book fines vary depending on the level of damage.

SCHOOL BREAKFAST, LUNCH, & DINNER

Breakfast and lunch are free for all students for the 2017-2018 SY.

DUAL ENROLLMENT AND ADVANCED PLACEMENT COURSES

All costs for students enrolled in Dual Enrollment and Advanced Placement Courses are the responsibility of the student and/or parent. This includes costs of tuition, textbooks, exams, and student fees charged by the college or agency. Current tuition charges are as follows:
