Students:

- Students are working hard and earning ClassDojo points for being productive, responsible and respectful.
- Students are working hard to "Level Up" on Reading Plus. (See videos posted on Facebook.)
- Students participated in a virtual Spirit Day (Pajama and Hat Day) on Wednesday, September 23, 2020.
- Below provides a snapshot of the number of students attending LIVE Zoom lessons.
 This data was collected during principal observations. I observed all core content area teachers. As I observed each teacher, I noted the number of students enrolled in the class as well as the number of students who attended the live Zoom lesson. The total was 388 students. The number of students who attended live was 333. That's 86% of students attending LIVE Zoom lessons.

Guidance:

- Tracked down all students unaccounted for/transferred records for all withdrawing students.
- Reached out to parents when students aren't attending phone, dojo, email, home visits.
- Reached out to parents when students aren't doing work phone, dojo, email, home visits.
- Conducted individual counseling with students on Zoom with parent consent.
- Conducted classroom guidance with all classes PreK-5th for the month of September.
- Scheduled all classroom guidance lessons for October.
- Started new students/met with families to pick up IPads.
- Completed observations for students for special education eligibility determination.
- Attended parent/teacher conferences on September 17th and 18th.
- Trained staff on Suicide Prevention (October 1st)

Principal:

- Conducted 29 formal observations. Each observation lasted 60 minutes (with the
 exceptions of specials and Title I, 30 minute observations) and teachers were
 provided with detailed feedback regarding their performance.
- Scheduled and facilitated 15 School Based Intervention Team Meetings. These
 meetings include the following individuals: general education teacher, special
 education teacher, principal, parent(s), reading coach, Title I teachers and any other
 specialist that works with the student.
- Facilitated data meetings with every grade level for all core content areas with the
 exception of PreK and Kindergarten as these grade levels are currently taking PALS
 assessments. PreK and K data meetings will be held as soon as PALS assessments are
 completed. During data meetings, small group interventions were developed to help
 provide remediation to students who are struggling in reading and math.
- Conducted six home visits with the Director of Students Services, Mr. Styer.
- Communicate with parents frequently via phone, email, in-person and Dojo Messages.

Parents:

- Parent-teacher conferences were held on September 17th and 18th. Below is the data for each grade level. Conferences were held via phone.
 - PreK: 100% parent attendance! PreK has a total of 31 students. All parents attended conferences.
 - K: 41 conferences scheduled; 31 attended.
 - 1st grade: 20 conferences scheduled; 18 attended.
 - 2nd grade: 25 conferences scheduled; 23 attended.
 - 3rd grade: 27 conferences scheduled; 21 attended.
 - 4th grade: 14 conferences scheduled; 10 attended.
 - 5th grade: 25 conferences scheduled; 22 attended.
 - 6th grade: 13 conferences scheduled; 11 attended.
 - 7th grade: 10 conferences scheduled; 16 attended.

Teachers:

- \bullet Teachers scheduled and held parent-teacher conferences on September 17th and 18th. We extended our conferences to ensure that every parent had the opportunity to conference. (See the conference data under the Parent heading).
- 29/32 teachers were observed as of 10/5/2020.

 All teachers are doing a great job managing CANVAS. All CANVAS pages were reviewed. I am so proud of our teachers for learning a brand new learning management system and implementing it virtually!
