Today, August 18, 2022, the Virginia Department of Education (VDOE) released the 2021-2022 SOL results for all public schools across the Commonwealth. The scores for the commonwealth of Virginia show a downward spiral in mathematics and reading. A major area of concern is in mathematics; particularly with the Black, Hispanic, Economically Disadvantaged, English Language Learners, and Special Education subgroups.

Our scores at Colonial Beach Public Schools do not reflect what is contained in the report. We are not where we want to be; however, we are very proud of our hard-working students and educators, who returned in person last year and gave their very best efforts to educate our students under difficult conditions.
